# **Ask Your Risk Management Committee**

You asked and the Risk Management Committee answered. Read recent questions submitted to the Risk Management Committee below, and previous Q & A in the Bearings Newsletter archives.

Q: Eight months ago, both the buyer and the seller claimed the earnest money in connection with a failed transaction. I did not hear anything on this until the buyer called recently and requested the money. Can I release the earnest money to the buyer without contacting the seller?

**A:** Once a dispute has occurred, the law requires a REALTOR<sup>®</sup> to keep the EMD until the parties reach an agreement or until there is a court order directing the release of funds. After a dispute arises, there I no provision that allows a REALTOR<sup>®</sup> to release the deposit after a stated time period has elapsed.

**Q**: I am representing the sellers in the sale of their house. There have been some delays and the buyer is asking for yet another extension. My sellers will

only give the buyer another extension if the buyer agrees to a \$2,000 non-refundable deposit. I have heard that non-refundable deposits are illegal. Is this true?

**A:** No. A buyer and seller can certainly agree that a deposit will be non-refundable. You will want to make certain that this is explicitly stated in the contract so that there can be no argument about the parties' intent.

Q: My buyers are having second thoughts about going ahead with the purchase of a home. Can they just walk away from the transaction and forfeit their earnest money or are there other potential risks?

**A:** Some purchase contracts provide that in the event of a default by the buyers, the sellers' only remedy is to keep the buyers' EMD as "liquidated damages." However, many, perhaps most, purchase agreements provide that in the event the buyers default, the sellers can keep the EMD and sue the buyers for damages. Your buyers should be encouraged to consult with an attorney.

Q: I have funds in my trust account from a failed transaction that happened several years ago. I cannot locate either party to the transaction. What should I do with this money?

**A:** Unclaimed EMDs become the property of the State of Michigan after 3 years (i.e., it "escheats" to the State). There is a process that must be followed for surrendering these funds. Details can be found at:

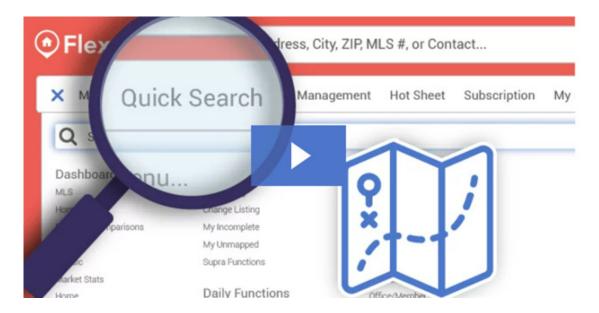

MichRIC<sup>®</sup> will be retiring sub-areas from Flexmls by summer of 2023. You will no longer need to select a sub-area when entering a listing or when conducting a Quick Search.
